1. Policy Statement

LL Plastic Ltd is committed to operating in an environmentally responsible manner and to continually improving the environmental performance of its business activities.

As a company focused on supplying recycled-plastic products as a durable alternative to traditional materials, we recognise our responsibility to reduce environmental impact, promote resource efficiency, prevent pollution, and support circular-economy principles wherever reasonably practicable.

We aim to conduct our operations in a way that protects the environment, complies with applicable legal and other relevant requirements, and supports sustainable growth for our business, customers, and wider community.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all activities carried out by LL Plastic Ltd, including:

- manufacturing and fabrication activities
- storage, warehousing, and site operations
- packaging and distribution
- procurement and supplier engagement
- office-based administration
- waste handling and recycling
- product development and continuous improvement

It applies to all employees, directors, contractors, and others working on behalf of LL Plastic Ltd.

3. Our Environmental Commitments

LL Plastic Ltd is committed to:

3.1 Legal and regulatory compliance

We will comply with applicable environmental laws, regulations, permits, and other requirements relevant to our operations, products, transport, storage, and waste handling.

3.2 Pollution prevention

We will take reasonable steps to prevent pollution and reduce the risk of harm to land, air, and water arising from our activities, including from waste, emissions, spills, dust, noise, and improper material handling.

3.3 Waste reduction and recycling

We will minimise waste generation wherever practicable and promote reuse, recycling, and recovery over disposal. We will manage waste responsibly and use licensed or otherwise appropriate waste service providers where required.

3.4 Efficient use of materials and resources

We will seek to improve the efficient use of raw materials, packaging, energy, fuel, and water in our operations, and reduce unnecessary consumption wherever possible.

3.5 Support for the circular economy

We will support the circular economy by promoting the use of recycled materials, designing for durability and long service life, and encouraging practical alternatives to short-life or high-maintenance materials.

3.6 Sustainable procurement

Where reasonably practicable, we will consider environmental factors in purchasing decisions, including material choice, product durability, transport efficiency, packaging, and supplier practices.

3.7 Product responsibility

We aim to supply long-life products that reduce maintenance demand, avoid premature replacement, and offer a practical reuse of waste plastic. We will continue to improve products and processes with environmental performance in mind.

3.8 Energy and transport awareness

We will seek to reduce environmental impact associated with electricity use, fuel consumption, delivery planning, and logistics through sensible operational controls and continuous improvement.

3.9 Training and awareness

We will make employees aware of this policy and encourage responsible environmental behaviour in day-to-day work, including good housekeeping, waste segregation, efficient use of resources, and reporting of environmental risks.

3.10 Continual improvement

We will review our environmental objectives and working practices periodically and seek ongoing improvement in environmental performance appropriate to the size and nature of our business.

4. Practical Measures

To support this policy, LL Plastic Ltd will, where appropriate:

- reduce avoidable waste in production and packaging
- separate recyclable materials where practical
- store materials and waste in a controlled and safe manner
- keep work areas clean and organised to reduce spills, contamination, and unnecessary waste
- monitor material usage and look for opportunities to reduce loss
- maintain equipment and tools to support efficient operation
- encourage efficient vehicle loading and sensible delivery planning
- avoid unnecessary printing and reduce paper use in office functions
- review packaging and transport methods where improvements are feasible
- work with suppliers and partners who share responsible environmental values where possible

5. Responsibilities

Directors and management

Directors and management are responsible for:

- supporting this policy and promoting environmental responsibility
- ensuring appropriate environmental controls are in place
- considering environmental issues in planning and decision-making
- reviewing environmental performance and opportunities for improvement
- ensuring relevant employees understand their responsibilities

Employees and contractors

Employees and contractors are expected to:

- work in accordance with this policy
- follow environmental procedures and site rules
- use materials, equipment, water, and energy responsibly
- dispose of waste correctly
- report spills, leaks, hazards, or other environmental concerns promptly
- help identify practical improvements where possible

6. Environmental Objectives

LL Plastic Ltd may set environmental objectives from time to time, appropriate to the size and activities of the business. These may include objectives relating to:

- reduction of waste
- increased recycling
- improved material efficiency
- packaging reduction
- energy awareness
- improved housekeeping and storage controls
- better supplier and logistics practices

Progress against objectives will be reviewed periodically by management.

7. Monitoring and Review

This policy will be reviewed at least annually, or sooner if there are significant changes to business operations, environmental risks, legal requirements, or customer expectations.
